

Outline Comparisons - 4 sections of SPC 1600, Fundamentals of Speech - Fall 2008

1. The *Percent of Change Draft to Informative 1 Outline* represents the percentage change in outline grades (see Grading Rubrics).
2. The *Percent of Change Informative 1 to Informative 2* represent the percentage change in outline grades (see Grading Rubric).
3. The *Percent of Change Informative 2 to Persuasive* represent the percentage change in outline grades (see Grading Rubrics).
4. The *comparison (number)* equals the total number of outlines being compared. For example: 93 draft outlines and 90 informative 1 outlines were submitted among all sections for a total of 183 total outlines being compared.
5. All sections were face-to-face. Two sections met for 50 minutes, 3 times a week; 2 sections met for 75 minutes, 2 times a week.
